

La Chaîne des Rôtisseurs, JCR Competition 2026

The International Jeunes Chef Rôtisseurs Competition Committee, through la Chaîne des Rôtisseurs, has offered guidelines outlining steps that can be implemented to provide an environment as safe as possible when meeting in-person. Responsibility is shared equally among the Committee, the event venue and those attending the competition – **all have a role to play**. This includes you --- as a Competitor, an Official Companion, a Member of the Jury, a Committee Member, or an Official Observer.

The Code of Conduct below is meant to serve as a reminder and inspiration to know that if we all collectively respect the significance of this contribution, we are advocating for the well-being of our fellow global membership and our industry.

Code of Conduct

Before leaving home

- Follow relevant guidance provided by the World Health Organization (WHO), or your local health authority.
- Adhere to government issued travel restrictions and guidance issued by the region you will be travelling to and the region you are travelling from.
- Evaluate your own health and that of people you are in close contact with; contact the JCR Committee if you have concerns.
- Stay at home if you are feeling unwell.
- Check if you need a visa to enter the country. This should not be left to the last minute.

On-site during the Competition week

- Follow guidance from your local health authority, for everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of viruses
- Agree to have your temperature taken when required by the Committee. Failure to agree will result in disqualification from the competition.
- Agree to wear a mask or facial covering when required by the Committee.
- Adhere to social distance protocols put in place by the Committee and respect the personal space of others.
- If you feel unwell or are experiencing flu-like symptoms notify the Committee immediately and remain in your room.

Events During Competition Week

- All competitors are required to attend all events. If you have an Official Companion travelling with you, then the Official Companion is also required to attend all events. If you voluntarily do not attend an event, marks will be deducted from your final score, or you will be disqualified, depending on the severity of the situation.
- You are representing la Chaine in your country, and la Chaine international. You are expected to dress and act with courteousness and decorum. This is professionalism.

Post-event

Based on current contact tracing advice from many health authorities, if you test positive for COVID-19 up to 14 days after returning home, please contact the JCR Committee to advise them.
